Dear Drs. Lonski and Llewellyn,

This is to confirm that the New York Post has published an "Editor's Note" regarding an October 5, 2008, article entitled "Shrink Rap: PA Hires Frauds for WTC Site" (http://www.nypost.com/seven/10052008/news/regionalnews/shrink_rap_pa_hires_frauds_for_wtc_site_132238.htm).

The Editor's Note states:

"On November 13, 2008, after a review of the dealings between Life Matters, Inc., the Firefighter's National Trust, and FNT founder Stephen Careaga, the Connecticut Attorney General determined that no further investigation was warranted and that its inquiry is closed.

Further, The Post wishes to make clear that its use of the word "frauds" in the headline of this article was not intended to suggest that Life Matters or the Lonskis were ever found to have committed fraud. The civil Medicare allegations against Michael Lonski and L&L Psychological Services, P.C., were settled in 2002 with no finding or admission of wrongdoing, and no charges were ever made against Evelyn Lonski individually or against Life Matters.

In addition, we have received documentation from Life Matters that shows Life Matters did in fact work with Mt. Sinai Hospital by counseling victims of the World Trade Center attacks and that, prior to the removal of the union's support in 2005, Life Matters did work with members of the UFA, with the approval of the UFA, post-9/11."
